



General responsibilities shall be to perform as directed, and to do responsible work in Emergency Medical Services as required.

## **Typical duties:**

- 1. Performs patient assessment.
- 2. Takes vitals blood pressures, pulse, respirations, etc.
- 3. Applies splints.
- 4. Applies bandages and dressings.
- 5. Performs CPR.
- 6. Administers Oxygen.
- 7. Attends fire department monthly meetings.
- 8. Performs other duties as required.

## Minimum requirements are as follows:

- 1. Must be accepted by the Board of Supervisors.
- 2. Must have and maintain Minnesota EMSRB certification in one of the following;
  - a. First Responder
  - b. EMT
  - c. Paramedic
- Current AHA Health Care Provider Certification.
- 4. Must attend 30% of all EMS calls received per year.
- 5. Must attend 50% of fire department training.
- 6. Must possess a valid Minnesota driver's license.
- 7. Must pass the following Federal Emergency Management Administration (FEMA) Independent study courses
  - a. IS 700 Introduction to the National Incident Management System
  - b. IS 100 Introduction to Incident Command
- 8. Must complete a biennial physical examination as specified by the department.
- 9. Must pass a criminal background check and drivers license background check.

## Requirements of work:

- 1. Possess a math aptitude.
- Able to read and understand fire department information including but not limited to training material, policies, personnel rules, and Standard Operating Guidelines.
- 3. Able to write legibly to complete training and testing materials.
- 4. Skill in the operation and use of emergency medical equipment.
- 5. Provide medical care.
- 6. Write incident reports on paper and online computer software.
