Noxious Weed Law

• 18.78 - Control or Eradication of Noxious Weeds

A person owning land, a person occupying land, or a person responsible for the maintenance of public land <u>SHALL</u> control or eradicate all noxious weeds on the land at a time and in a manner ordered by the county agricultural inspector or county-designated employee MS 18.78 Subd. 1
